1. Share a picture of a textile that captured your attention and possibly inspired your work.
2. Where did you go and when did you go there?
3. Where was the textile seen? Museum, foreign location, marketplace
4. What age is it, approximately? It's ok to be a contemporary work.
5. What kind of textile is it? Rug, table cloth, garment, etc.
6. What is it made from? Fiber?
7. Can you identify a technique?
8. Did you find out any history associated with the textile?
9. Did you research any related information to learn more or share with the group?
10. Have you used the images or the colors as an inspiration for your weaving?
11. What did you make that was stoked by having found this textile? Do you have a picture to share?
12. Include your full name and your town for the presentation slide
13. Include a photo credit if appropriate
